School Governors meet five times a year to discuss the running of the School. The contents of this document represents the information required in Schedule 2 of the Education (School Information) Regulations 1981 and relates to the school year September 2008 - September 2009. The information was correct as at 21st April 2009. It should not be assumed that there will be no change affecting the arrangements described in this document before the start of, or during the school year in question, or in relation to subsequent school years.

The School is a Community First School, which has children aged from 4-8 years. It is planned to federate with Westcott Cof E First School as from September 2009 and amalgamate in September 2010. The children are able to transfer to Dorking schools at 8 years old, at the end of Year 3 for the year 2009/2010. As from 2010 it is planned that the Year 3 children from Abinger Common will feed into the Junior Department of the proposed amalgamated school, which will be based on the Westcott site.
